Evaluate ~ Learn ~ Grow

Because we take the Great Commission seriously, we are intentionally coaching churches and pastors to create productive, healthy, and missional communities.

Prior to the coaching process, churches complete a self-study which usually takes about two months. Then the coaching team will come and be part of a consultation. This is a weekend where the staff, leadership board, and focus group of the church are interviewed. Then a limited number of recommendations are made to the congregation for approval. Covenants are signed to provide accountability with state, church and pastor. Everything is clearly understood.

Our Maximum Impact Learning Clusters are one mechanism for coaching the implementation of the consultation recommendations. In addition these clusters enable pastors to sharpen their skills, gain understanding of their own strengths/weaknesses, and provide accountability through the process.

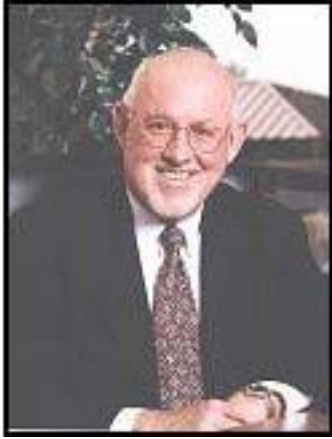

WHAT IS MAXIMUM IMPACT?

MAXIMUM IMPACT is designed to strengthen, sharpen, and network pastors and churches in regional areas. MAXIMUM IMPACT will help pastors stay healthy, fulfilled, and effective in ministry.

MAXIMUM IMPACT will help keep minds sharp, spirits renewed, ministries productive, and hearts connected with God and one another. We desire to alter the culture of ministry, specifically the way ministry is carried out in the Church of God: helping health and growth become intentional, so that churches and pastors working in partnership is the norm, not the exception.

WHO IS LEADING MAXIMUM IMPACT?

MAXIMUM IMPACT is a ministry under the umbrella of Florida Church of God Ministries and led by Doug Talley, (State Church Health Coach) and Elton Hume (Pastoral Health Coach).

WHAT DOES THE MINISTRY LOOK LIKE?

Maximum Impact involves meeting together with other pastors in a monthly learning cluster for personal, spiritual, and professional growth. These pastors and their churches will be asked to enter into a three-year covenant agreement of self-discovery, collaboration with others, and a commitment to the components necessary for growth. We recommend that you recruit 4-6 other pastors and join as a cluster or you can sign up and be assigned to a cluster. Each pastor will undergo assessments to discover their personal and professional health and identify areas for growth. These assessments will result in a personalized Life And Ministry Plan (LAMP) for maximum development. There will also be components of training, coaching, and networking for each cohort group. A maximum of 15- 20 pastors will be admitted into this ministry each year.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

MAXIMUM IMPACT is intended to be a partnership effort, both in time and finances. The expenses are expected to be shared by state, participant, and congregational funds.

HOW MUCH TIME IS EXPECTED FROM THE PARTICIPANTS?

Realizing that pastors have many time expectations already, MAXIMUM IMPACT strives to make this three-year commitment worthwhile and beneficial for the pastor and his/her ministry. Time expectations are:

- Orientation Retreat – two 2-day sessions scheduled for October 6-7, 2006 and November 10-11, 2006
- One full day per month for cohort meetings
- Occasional special events (seminars, marriage)
- Some book reading/occasional homework
