# Apostolic...Paul

- ◆ Catalytic...Romans 15.20 *"It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else's foundation"*
- ◆ Chaotic...Titus 1.5 *"The reason I left you in Crete was that you might straighten out what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you."*

# Apostolic...Paul

- ◆ Challenging...Galatians 2.11 Peter and the Jews *"When Peter came to Antioch, I apposed him to his face, because he was clearly in the wrong"*
- ◆ Vision Driven...Acts 15.39 Paul and Barnabus

# Shepherd...Peter

- ◆ Stayed in Jerusalem...Acts 8-11
- ◆ People Oriented...Galatians 2.11  
hanging out with people
- ◆ Nurturing...John 21.15ff "...feed my sheep"
- ◆ Stable...Matthew 16.18 "upon this rock..."

# Teacher...Apollos

*Meanwhile a Jew named Apollos, a native of Alexandria, came to Ephesus. He was a learned man, man with a thorough knowledge of the Scriptures. He had been instructed in the way of the Lord, and he spoke with great fervor and taught about Jesus accurately, though he know only the baptism of Jesus. He began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When Priscilla and Aquila heard him, they invited him to their home and explained to him the way of God more adequately. When Apollos wanted to go to Achaia, the brothers encouraged him and wrote to the disciples there to welcome him. On arriving, he was a great help to those who by grace had believed. For he vigorously refuted the Jews in public debate, proving from the scriptures that Jesus was the Christ. (Acts 18.24-28 NIV)*
